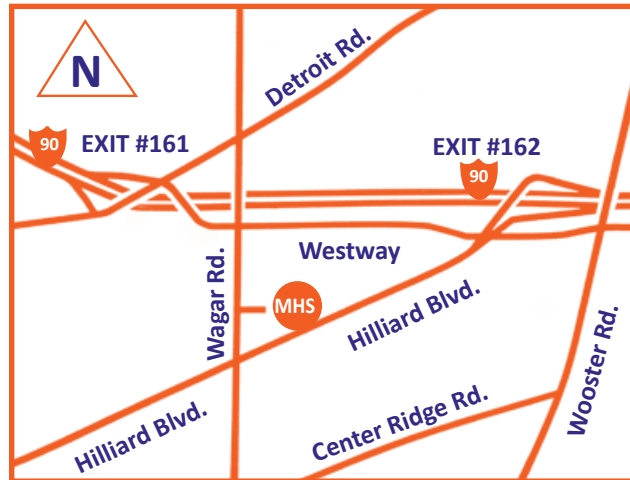

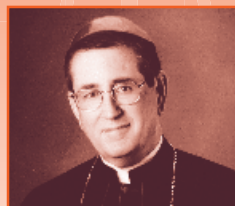
PATTI MANSFIELD

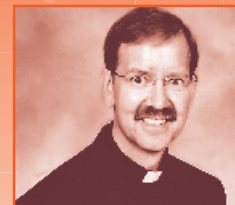
**THE MOST REVEREND
